

WinCrest Care Instructions

Important!

WinCrest acts as a protective layer on the windshield. It reduces chances for the glass to break.

Next 72 hours

WinCrest may take up to 72 hours to fully cure and bond to glass.

Therefore, we recommend avoiding leaving the vehicle out in extreme weather conditions, driving on rough roads or getting a commercial wash during this period.



To extend product life span Cleaning

1 Regular maintenance

- Clean your windshield using the above materials at least once a week.
- Please make sure you rinse it well after cleaning.

2 Cleaning materials

Use a clean microfiber cloth, sponge, clay bar, or soft brush to prevent scratching.

Ammonia-Free Glass Cleaner

or



Mild Soap & Water

3 Clean immediately

Substances such as tree sap, bird dropping, salt spray, insects, tar, oils etc. should be cleaned off immediately.

To extend product life span Avoid

1 Sharp objects, direct high-pressure water (stay at least 3ft [1m] away when spraying), harsh chemicals, hard brushes etc.

2 Leaving your car parked in extreme heat.

To extend product life span Wiper Care

1 Use washer fluid

Always use washer fluid when using your wipers to prevent scratching the film.

2 Clean under the wiper blades

Use a microfiber cloth with washer fluid or ammonia-free glass cleaner to wipe along the underside of the blades to remove any kind of residue.

3 We recommend replacing wipers once every 3-6 months.

Recommendation

- Get new wipers.
- Try switching to silicon wipers.
- Limit unnecessary wiper usage.
- Refrain from using wipers on auto-mode.
